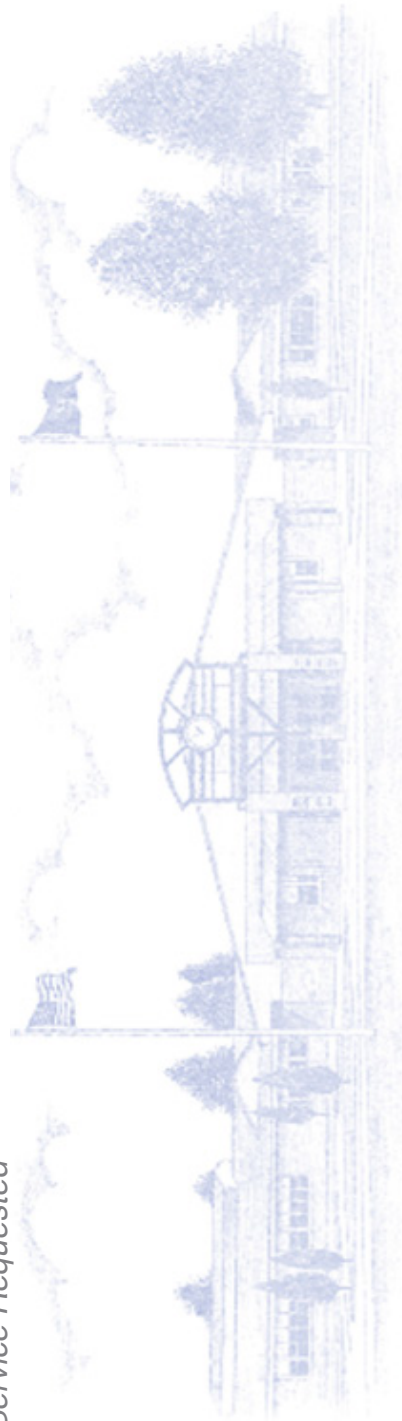


Olympia High School Foundation Mission Statement

Olympia High School Classroom Fund, a 501(c)3 project of the OHS Foundation, was founded in March 2009 by OHS parents and alumni to help maintain the quality educational experience for OHS students despite current budget constraints.

Over the last 6 years, the Classroom Fund has received 100+ donations totaling more than \$13,000. One hundred percent of these funds went to support the educational mission at OHS.

Items Purchased Included:

Compound microscopes, foreign language dictionaries, textbooks, choir robes, student tutoring stipends, assemblies as well as sponsorship of the school newspaper.
