

# Olympia High School Running Start General Information and Reminders

- Students must enroll in 100 level courses or above.
- Tuition is paid, but students are responsible for student activity fees, books, transportation, lab fees, parking, online class fees and supplies.
- Students must maintain a “C” grade or better to remain eligible for Running Start. This is SPSCC’s policy.
- Your high school Counselor must sign your Running Start Registration form each and every quarter. Forms can be picked up in the Counseling Center, at SPSCC or printed from either the SPSCC Website or the OHS Website you’re looking at now.
- After the first registration is complete, a PIN will be sent to the high school for you to use each quarter thereafter. Students receive PINs from their High School Counselor, after they return the registration forms for signature.
- Withdrawal from Running Start classes at SPSCC is permitted and the college determines dates for withdrawal. A “W” will be placed on the transcript. There is no penalty for withdrawal if the deadline is met. Students who receive a “V”, meaning the student vanished, will receive an “F” grade on their OHS Transcript.
