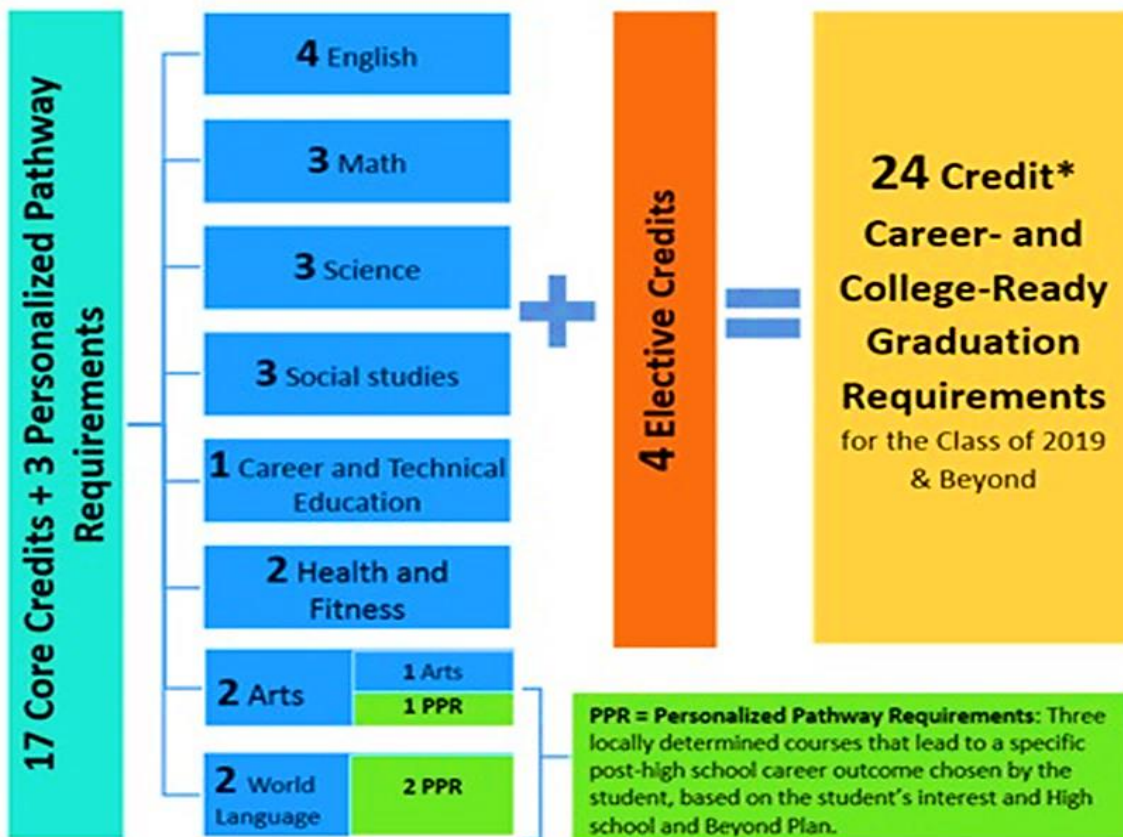

**High School Graduation Requirements:**

- 1) **Earn 24 Credits:** The Career and College Ready diploma is intended to be both rigorous and flexible to help students achieve their post-secondary goals. Learn more at The Washington State Board of Education’s website: <http://www.sbe.wa.gov/graduation.php#.WNaaKVXyuWV>.
- 2) **Meet State Testing Requirements:** Students are required to demonstrate or exceed a standard level of proficiency in math, English, and science (biology) on the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA). Alternative options to meet this requirement are detailed on the OSPI Graduation Alternatives webpage.
- 3) **Complete a High School & Beyond Plan (HSBP):** The HSBP is a formal process designed to help students think about their future goals and identify steps to accomplish those goals. This includes exploring interests and career options, developing a course plan for each year of high school, and exploring opportunities to develop skills. Students develop, review, and reflect on their HSBP annually.

**Personal Pathway Requirements (PPR)** is a new flexible option for students to meet the 24 credit graduation requirement. This allows the student to select courses that work toward their specific career interest goal(s) and education plan as identified in their High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP). Students may use a PPR class for one of two required Fine Arts Credits and/or up to two credits of the World Language requirement if these courses are not required to reach their post-secondary goals and align with their HSBP.
