

AP Chemistry Application Questions:

1. Chemistry involves the manipulation of matter, which is constantly happening around and to us all. List 3 occurrences of chemistry in your everyday life and explain these in the chemical terms you learned in first year chemistry.
2. For the 3 occurrences you mentioned in question #1, write the chemical equations that are happening as best you can. Identify what part of the occurrence the equation is being written for and be complete.
3. The AP Chemistry class is believed by many teachers and students to be the hardest AP class. Many college professors who write questions for the test write the questions to show how you will apply chemical concepts that are complex and not yet fully understood. Explain in one paragraph what you will do to prepare for such a challenge in your everyday preparation for the AP Chemistry Class. (I expect 3-5 specific strategies.)
4. If you are in the 10th grade this year, and the AP Chemistry class does not get enough students or funding to happen next year in your junior year, would you try again to take AP Chemistry as a senior?
