(This form must be completed by all students who plan to take **more than 3 honors/AP classes** at one time.

While we believe students should have the opportunity to participate in rigorous and academically challenging courses, we also realize limits need to be placed on the number of AP courses students take in one school year. These courses are taught at the college level, and every student enrolled in an AP class must take that exam in the spring to keep the AP label on the transcript. Therefore, we recommend students enroll in a maximum of three AP courses (which is equivalent to a full college load) in a school year. Students who wish to take more than three must have a conference with the AP Coordinator and a school counselor.
