

**Test Corrections** *(or How do I raise my grade?)*

Test corrections are an opportunity to evaluate your thinking on test questions, learn the best answers, and improve your test grade. The portion of the test (70%) directly assessing the 2009 WA State Science Standards can be corrected.

**Requirements:**

- Must be completed within one week of test return
- Must be completed in the classroom (may arrange with another teacher if necessary)

**What you do:**

- Start with a blank sheet of notebook paper
- From your corrected answer sheet, record the questions missed
- Search notes, text, *(if all else fails ask your instructor for guidance)* to determine the correct answer. **Do not collaborate with other students!**
- Write the new answer on the notebook paper
- Explain why the answer is correct (using biology concepts and terms)
- Turn in the completed corrections to the “ In box”

**What you earn:**

- You will receive half credit for each answer completed correctly.
- This will show as a separate item in the grade book

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
