

Culminating Project Vital Dates -- Fall 2007

For Single Semester CP(O) Classes Only

- **September 5:** First Day of 1st Semester.
 - **September 19: CP Seminar #1 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
 - **September 26: CP Seminar #2 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
- **October 1:** Preliminary Project Proposals due.
- **October 15** Detailed Project Proposals Due.
- **October 15-November 26:** Project Activities: Research and product creation.
 - **October 17: CP Seminar #3 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
- **Ongoing:** Documentation (Journal, Annotated Bibliography) is reviewed and evaluated by faculty advisor.
 - **Journals should be read/evaluated every 2-3 weeks.**
 - **Each supervising teacher sets due dates for drafts of Annotated Bibliography**
 - **Product creation progress should be checked occasionally.**
 - **November 7 (Revised Date): CP Seminar #4 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
- **November 5:** Deadline to submit Addenda to proposals. **No project changes after this date.**
 - **November 14: CP Seminar #5 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
- **November 26:** Final Product, Journal, and Annotated Bibliography should be complete and turned in.
- **November 26-December 10:** Prepare for presentations.
 - **November 28: CP Seminar #6 (8 AM in the Lecture Hall)**
- **December 10:** Product/documentation evaluation and any re-do's should be complete.
