

The Verb Ir (to go)

- Review and study the conjugation of ir

yo voy nosotros(as) vamos

tú vas

él/ella/usted va ellos/ellas/ustedes van

Ir+a+ place

Voy a la biblioteca. (I am going to the library.)

Vas a la cafetería. (You are going to the cafeteria.)

Va al gimnasio. (He/She/You is(are) going to the gym.)

¿Adónde vas, Susana? (Where are you going, Susana?)

Voy a la escuela. (I am going to school.)

EXPLANATION:

Use ir a to say that you or others are going to a specific place.

When a is followed by el, it becomes the contraction al.

Use the word adónde to ask where someone is going.
