

Olympia High School Running Start General Information and Reminders

- Running Start students are funded to take 100 level courses or above only.
- Summer Quarter classes are not funded through the Running Start program. Students may still take summer courses but are responsible for tuition and all other costs.
- Running Start students must maintain an SPSCC grade point average of “C” or better to remain eligible for the program according to SPSCC policy.
- Running Start students are responsible for knowing, understanding and completing high school graduation requirements including their **High School and Beyond Plan**.
- Running Start students should check the **OHS Daily Bulletin** for pertinent information and calendar events. Students should also check their **SPSCC email** and **OHS email** as often as possible for important information.
- Running Start students are required to obtain their High School Counselor’s signature on the **“SPSCC Enrollment and Verification Form”** every quarter of enrollment. It is the student’s responsibility to return the signed verification form to the Registrar at SPSCC by the deadline determined by SPSCC. This information is sent to students throughout the year to their SPSCC email account.
- Withdrawal from a class at SPSCC is permitted and withdrawal grades determined by the college according to their policy. There is no penalty for withdrawal if the student meets the deadline established by the college. **“V”** grades or **“Vanish”** equate to **“F”** grades on the OHS transcript.
